The Black Creek Youth Initiative model focuses on a youth led and youth decided approach as a direct response to the needs of the young people.

Combined with art-based, and alternative educational workshops and programming, young people equipped to address systemic barriers and make better decisions regarding their physical and mental well being.

This is an excellent opportunity to expand your own abilities and provide leadership at a strategic level.

Requirements include:

- A commitment to BCYI mission, vision, and values
- Prepare for, attend, and participate in all Board meetings (6-7 per year on Wednesday evenings at 5:00 p.m.)
- Membership on a minimum of one committee of the Board, meeting an average of 3 – 4 times per year
- Preference will be given to candidates with a reflection of and / or connection to one or more of the communities BCYI serves.



We are currently particularly interested in candidates with the

following competencies:

- Lived experience with and / or interest in creating safe spaces for young people
- Finance/Accounting professionals
- Legal professionals
- Human Resource professionals
- Previous Board governance experience is considered an asset

Timeline – Recruitment & Onboarding

- The Black Creek Youth Initiative accepts applications at any time, but only those applications received by MARCH 31 in a given year will be considered when electing three new directors each June.
- Interviews will take place in April / May 2023.
- Short-listed candidates will be invited to attend a Board meeting in June 2023.
- Successful candidates will be appointed as new Board Directors / Members in September 2023.
- Orientation for new Board Directors / Members will take place in October / November 2023.
