

Anti-Racism, Access, and Equity Policy for Black Creek Youth Initiative

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Black Creek Youth Initiative (BCYI) is committed to providing an inclusive, safe, and equitable environment for all youth ages 12 to 29 regardless of race, ethnicity, gender identity, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, ability, religion, or nationality. BCYI is committed to actively working to eliminate racism, discrimination, and oppression in all forms.

Anti-Racism Statement:
